- location: Central Europe, Southeastern Europe and the Mediterranean
- bordering Slovenia, Hungary, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro
- long maritime border with Italy in the Adriatic Sea
- 1,185 islands - **The land of thousand islands**
- population of about 4.3 million people
- the official language is Croatian



Republic of Croatia

- became an independent country on 25 June 1991
- a member of United Nations, the Council of Europe, NATO, The World Trade Organization and CEFTA
- a candidate for the European Union membership (July 2013)

- a population - about 800,000
- It is a political, cultural, economic, transport and sports center of the country

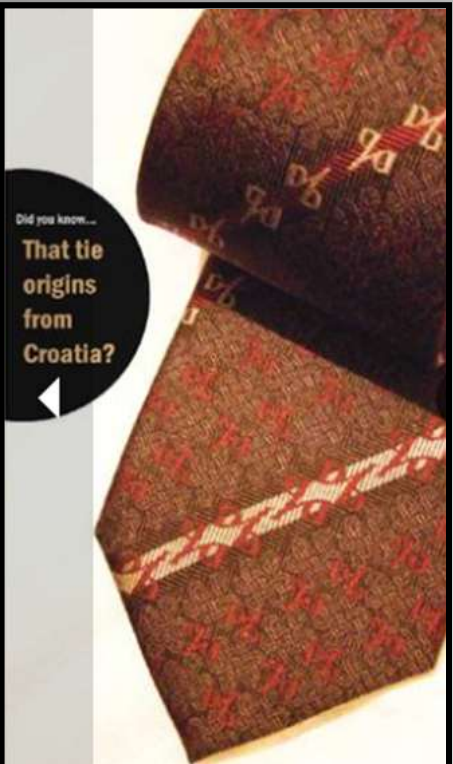

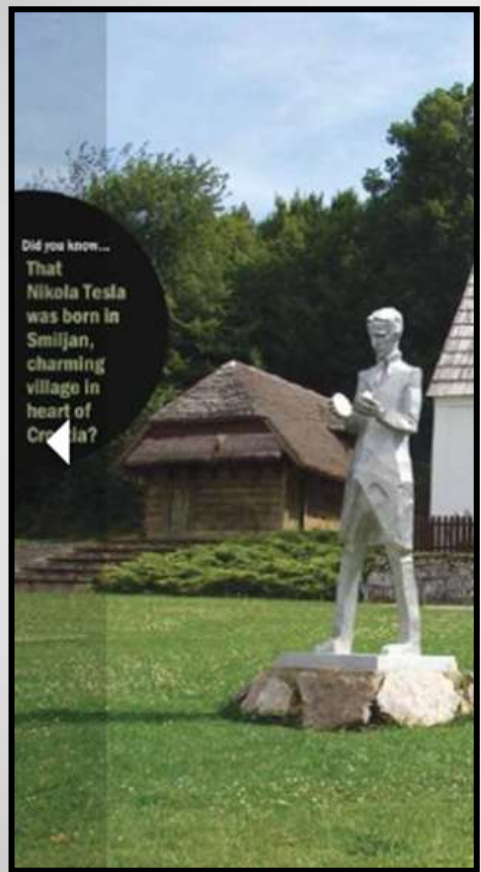
Plitvice Lakes

Croatia's flower garden

- Placed in the north of Croatia between two rivers Mura and Drava
- Međimurje has a beautiful countryside with hills and alluvial plain and it is therefore divided into two main parts – Upper and Lower Međimurje

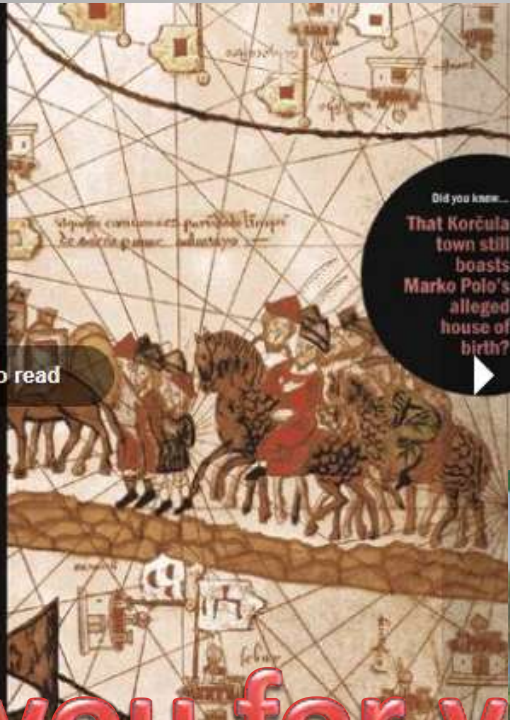

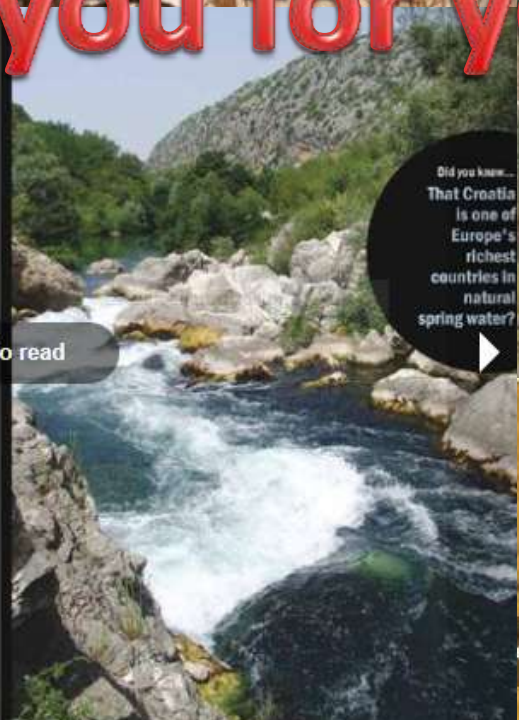
